

Request for Qualifications for Design Services for a Stormwater & Erosion Control, Access, and Vegetation Improvements at Frank Liske Park Soccer Complex

Project Description:

Cabarrus County is currently planning improvements on the stormwater and erosion control, public access, and vegetation at the Frank Liske Park Soccer Complex. The Frank Liske Park Soccer Complex is located at 4001 Stough Road, Concord, NC 28025. The intent of these improvements is to improve stormwater and erosion control structures at the complex, provide an improved method of field access, and provide native or adaptive vegetation to increase shading at the complex.

- Examples of design experience with multi-use athletic field complexes.
- Examples of stormwater and erosion control structures designed
